BALLET & CONTEMPORARY DANCE CONSERVATORY (Grades 7-12) In-Person Placement Activity

Placement Activity:

After your online application is processed you will be invited to participate in an in-person, 2-hour placement activity which will consist of the following:

- Grades 7-8: The placement activity incorporates a ballet barré and center, pre-pointe/pointe barré, and modern phase work.
- Grade 9-12: The placement activity incorporates a ballet barré and center, pointe barré and center exercises, and modern phase work.
- NO solo required for the placement activity.

Recommended Attire:

We highly recommend that you arrive dressed in the dance attire outlined below.

- Girls: Black leotard, pink/skin colored: tights, ballet slippers, and pointe shoes. Please have hair pulled back in a neat, secure bun.
- Boys: Black or white form fitting t-shirt. Black tights and black ballet slippers.
- Non-Binary Identifying: Any of the above variations. No loose clothing allowed.
